Job Title: **Trip Shack Coordinator**

POSITION SUMMARY

The Trip Shack Coordinator is responsible to further the mission of the camp through the development and delivery of tripping activities that are safe, fun, and appropriate to the campers' age and abilities. Assist in the management of the physical operation of the tripping program and related equipment.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Evaluate abilities of campers and staff related to the proposed trip.
- Set up the Trip shack during staff training.
- Participate in and lead specific areas of staff training pertaining to the trip shack and staff
 responsibilities with assigned equipment including coordinating equipment for staff training
 overnight.
- Coordinate coverage of the Trip Shack when on a day off or away driving.
- Evaluate the success of the tripping program.
- Teach cabins the skills necessary for a fun and safe trip before leaving camp, including personal and group health and safety, outdoor cooking and camping, comfortable travel methods, maintenance and care of equipment, emergency procedures, etc.
- Go over itineraries with campers and cabin leaders prior to trip.
- With the assistance of campers and staff, pack and load into vehicles all necessary camping and safety equipment, food, and water for the trip.
- Apply basic youth development principles in working with campers through communication, relationship development, respect for diversity, involvement and empowerment of youth.
- Ensure that camp staff and campers follow established safety guidelines.
- Check equipment and make (or file for) repairs when needed.
- Conduct daily check of the area and equipment for safety, cleanliness and good repair.
- Train other staff in their responsibilities on trips.
- Work with the Program Coordinator and Division Coordinator to schedule all shake downs or overnights and have food and supplies available.
- Monitor and assign all needed equipment at the beginning of each trip and ensure all equipment is returned in a timely manner and in good repair with exception to routine wear and tear.
- Order, pack and store all trip food and ensure all dehydrated food needs are met for each group and all shakedowns.
- Conduct initial and end of season inventory, and store equipment for safety.
- Ensure campers and staff follow safety procedures.
- Performs any other functions necessary for the smooth and efficient operation of camp to make experience the best it can be for our campers.

REQUIREMENTS/QUALIFICATIONS:

- Previous experience with wilderness trips.
- Current Certification in CPR/First Aid.
- At least 21 years of age.

- Ability to work in and adapt to all weather conditions.
